Hilferty

Creates a committee to study and evaluate the public safety implications of persons convicted of terrorism offenses being released from prison in La. or moving to La. from another state.

Provides that the committee shall be comprised of members appointed by the following persons or entities: the governor, attorney general, division of administration, Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, La. State Police, La. Supreme Court, La. Sheriffs' Association, and La. Association of Chiefs of Police.

Requires the committee to develop a system whereby persons convicted of terrorism offenses are required to register and provide notification to law enforcement of their presence within the law enforcement agency's jurisdiction.

Requires the committee to convene its first meeting no later than Sept. 1, 2018, and to report its findings to the La. Legislature no later than Feb. 1, 2019.
