AN ACT

To enact R.S. 37:1251(D) and R.S. 40:978(F)(3) and 978.3(E), relative to veterinarians; to exempt veterinarians and certain manufacturers from disclosure of prescription drug price information provisions; to exempt veterinarians from accessing the prescription monitoring program prior to prescribing an opioid; to exempt veterinarians from continuing education requirements for prescribers of controlled dangerous substances; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 37:1251(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1251. Disclosure of prescription drug price information

* * *

D. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to veterinarians or pharmaceutical marketers who engage in any form of prescription drug marketing directly to a prescriber, his designee, or any member of his staff regarding prescription drugs manufactured exclusively for nonhuman consumption.

Section 2. R.S. 40:978(F)(3) and 978.3(E) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

§978. Prescriptions

(3) The provisions of this Subsection shall not apply to individuals licensed by the Louisiana Board of Veterinary Medicine.
