## AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. $40: 979$, relative to the attempt or conspiracy to commit violations of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law; to provide relative to the penalties imposed for the attempt or conspiracy to distribute or possess with intent to distribute certain Schedule I controlled dangerous substances; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 40:979 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §979. Attempt and conspiracy
A. Exeept as otherwise provided herein, any Any person who attempts or conspires to commit any offense denouneedand/or made unlawfulby set forth in the provisions of this Part shall, upon conviction, be fined or imprisoned in the same manner as for the offense planned or attempted, but such fine or imprisonment shall not exceed one-half of the longest term of imprisonment prescribed for the offense, the commission of which was the object of the attempt or conspiracy.
B. Any person whe attempts or conspires to distribute or possess with intent to distribute any substance classified in Sehedute I, as provided for in R.S. 40:963 and R.S. 40:964, whieh is a nareotic drug (all substanees in Sehedule I preceded by an asterisk "*") shall, uponeonvietion, be imprisoned at hard labor for not less than eight nor more than fifty years without benefit of parole, probation or suspension of
