PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS: Provides relative to leases and subleases of land and buildings owned by a port, harbor, or terminal district

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds a provision that exempts the Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission from proposed law.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the lease or sublease of any land or buildings owned or leased by any port, harbor, or terminal district for processing, manufacturing, or commercial purposes.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides a maximum term of 40 years for a primary term at a fixed rate. Further provides an extension of the primary term of up to 99 years, provided the lease contains a clause for the readjustment of the rentals upon the expiration of a primary term of 40 years.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes any port, harbor, or terminal district to ratify, confirm, or approve any lease or sublease entered into pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>, whether lessor or lessee, if granted such authority by the port, harbor, or terminal district's governing authority.

Proposed law exempts the Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission from proposed law.
