1 A RESOLUTION

2 To express the condolences of the House of Representatives upon the death of Steven Paul
3 Lacombe of Simmesport, Louisiana.

4 WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives were saddened to learn
5 of the death on May 8, 2018, of Steven Paul Lacombe at the age of sixty-five; and

6 WHEREAS, Steven Paul Lacombe was born on July 12, 1952, to Merlin and Doris
7 Roy Lacombe and was a cherished brother to Faye, Tommy, Bubba, and Sue; and

8 WHEREAS, Steven married his high school sweetheart, Helen, and they had two
9 daughters, Angelle and Jill; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Lacombe spent his forty-four-year professional career in productive
11 service to Simmesport State Bank, eventually serving as president; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Lacombe also dedicated much of his personal time to the
13 betterment of his community: he served for fifteen years on the Avoyelles Parish School
14 Board, was an active member of the Simmesport Chamber of Commerce, and was a member
15 of the finance committee at Christ the King Catholic Church in Simmesport; and

16 WHEREAS, in his free time, Steven enjoyed boating, hunting, farming, and spending
17 time with his family; and

18 WHEREAS, as an advisor, banker, and friend, Mr. Lacombe touched the lives of
19 numerous families and supported countless businesses over the years, both within and
20 beyond Avoyelles Parish; and

1 WHEREAS, his family and friends will remember him with heartfelt affection for
2 his generous nature and love of his fellow man and with deep admiration for the strength and
3 tenacity he showed at the end of his life; and

4 WHEREAS, left to cherish the memory of Steven Paul Lacombe are his wife, Helen
5 Plauche Lacombe; daughters, Angelle "Angie" Lacombe Huff, and her husband Max, and
6 Jill Lacombe Gaspard, and her husband Travis; brother, Merlin "Bubba" Lacombe, Jr.;
7 sisters, Faye Juneau, and her husband Bruce, and Sue Lemoine, and her husband Kevin; and
8 a host of grandchildren, nephews, and nieces; and

9 WHEREAS, with the death of Steven Paul Lacombe, Louisiana has lost one of her
10 finest citizens.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
12 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby express sincere and heartfelt condolences upon the
