KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

RETIREMENT SYSTEMS. Provides that retention of membership in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana is not available to a person who becomes employed in a position covered by the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund. (6/30/18)

Present law allows a person with at least five years of service credit in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (TRSL) to retain membership in that system if the person moves to employment covered by another state or statewide retirement system.

Present law provides that the ability to retain TRSL membership does not apply to an employee covered by the Parochial Employees' Retirement System.

Proposed law provides that the ability to retain TRSL membership is not applicable to an employee covered by the Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund.

Effective June 30, 2018.
