3	consecutive Louisiana High School Athletic Association Class 5A state
4	championship.
5	WHEREAS, the Central High School Wildcats defeated the Sulphur High School
6	Tornadoes by a score of 4-0 on May 12, 2018, at McMurry Park in Sulphur, Louisiana, to
7	become the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Class 5A state champions
8	for the second consecutive year; and
9	WHEREAS, third baseman Dalton Aspholm and pitcher Hunter Arnold led the way
10	for the Wildcats; and
11	WHEREAS, Dalton Aspholm, the title game Most Valuable Player, had the two-RBI
12	hit that helped stake the Wildcats to a 3-0 lead in the fourth inning; and
13	WHEREAS, the sixth-seeded Sulphur Tornadoes had eight hits, compared to five for
14	the Wildcats, but pitcher Hunter Arnold's guile and craftiness, mixed with defense and a
15	little luck, was a winning combination and he struck out four and walked two in a
16	complete-game shutout; and
17	WHEREAS, in the bottom of the fourth inning, the Tornadoes were primed to score
18	when a throw bounced past Dalton Aspholm at third base but it bounced right back to him

1 off the fence allowing him to throw out a runner at the plate; and 2 WHEREAS, Dalton Aspholm finished 1-for-3 with the two RBIs, Sam Kenerson was 3 2-for-4, and Hunter Hebert and Brant Chauvin had RBI hits for the Wildcats; and 4 WHEREAS, the complexion of the game changed when the Wildcats strung together 5 three hits to score three runs in the fourth; and 6 WHEREAS, Tornadoes pitcher Haden Parker walked R.J. Coffee, Drew Lasseigne 7 singled, and two runners advanced on a passed ball before Dalton Aspholm slapped a single 8 to left field that scored Coffee and courtesy runner Andrew Cangelosi; and 9 WHEREAS, Dalton Aspholm took second on the throw and then scored on a single 10 by Brant Chauvin to make it 3-0, with Hunter Hebert adding an RBI hit in the seventh to 11 clinch the title; and 12 WHEREAS, the members of the talented Wildcats squad, Quint Guerin, Gabe 13 Baggett, Connor Cassels, Hunter Edwards, Brant Husser, Travis Dowden, Hunter Hebert, 14 Hunter Arnold, Drew Lasseigne, Sam Kenerson, Brody Knapps, Brant Chauvin, Carson 15 Balthazar, Eddie Pezant, Andrew Myrick, Nick Noble, Gabe Patterson, Todd Lasseigne, R.J. 16 Coffee, Andrew Cangelosi, Dalton Aspholm, Max Bryant, Brady Ellis, Tyler Furr, Connor Delaune, Parker Austin, Brodie Demoulin, and Josh Williams, merit recognition and 17 18 congratulations for their extraordinary performance and their competitive spirit throughout 19 the season and the tournament; and WHEREAS, the members of the team performed at the highest level of athletic 20 excellence throughout the tournament and each of them deserves recognition for their vital 21 22 contribution to the winning effort; and WHEREAS, Head Coach Mike Forbes, and assistant coaches, Brian Brown, Mike 23 24 Palermo, Ricky Creel, Antonio Ragusa, Hunter Edgens, Frank Fresina, and Clay Polk 25 instilled an ethic of winning and demonstrated the kind of leadership and motivational skills needed to produce winners both on and off the field; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Central High School Wildcats baseball team is recognized for the well-deserved accolades earned throughout the season and showcasing the extraordinary 28 29 athletic abilities they have displayed, particularly at the most difficult level of high school
