4	authority of the commissioner of agriculture; to require seed test confidentiality; to
5	provide relative to seed labeling; to provide for definitions; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 3:1431(19), 1435(5), 1436(4)(d) and (5)(e), and 1444(10) are hereby
9	amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§1431. Terms defined
11	As used in this Part, the following terms have the meanings given:
12	* * *
13	(19) "Noxious weeds" are weeds that are highly destructive injurious to the
14	environment, agricultural fields, lawns, or gardens and difficult to control by
15	good cultural practices and the use of herbicides.

17	§1435. Authority of the commissioner
18	The commissioner may:
19	* * *
20	(5) Make purity, and germination, and additional tests of seeds for persons
21	on upon request. The analyses shown by this test these tests shall be for the
22	information of the person requesting the test only and shall not be made the basis of
23	the guaranteed analysis of the seeds required by R.S. 3:1436 confidential and shall
24	be made available only to the requestor, unless otherwise specifically authorized
25	by the requestor.

27	§1436. Labeling of seeds

1	Each container of agricultural, vegetable, or flower seeds, or other
2	propagating stock that is sold or offered for sale in Louisiana for planting purposes
3	shall bear thereon or have attached thereto in a conspicuous place a label plainly
4	written or printed in the English language. The label shall give the following
5	information:

7	(4) On vegetable seeds in containers of one pound or less which germinate
8	equal to or above the standards established by the commission under the provisions
9	of R.S. 3:1433(3)(a):

11	(d) The calendar month and year of the germination test or the year for
12	which the seeds were packed for sale.
13	(5) On vegetable seeds in containers of one pound or less that germinate less
14	than the standards established by the commission under the provisions of R.S.
15	3:1433(3)(a):

17	(e) The calendar month and year the germination tests were completed or the
18	year for which the seeds were packed for sale.

20	§1444. Prohibitions
21	No person shall:
22	* * *
23	(10) Use relabeling stickers without having both the calendar, month, and
24	year the germination test was completed and the lot number that matches the
25	existing, original lot number.
26	Section 2. R.S. 44:4.1(B)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
27	§4.1. Exceptions
28	* * *
29	B. The legislature further recognizes that there exist exceptions, exemptions,
30	and limitations to the laws pertaining to public records throughout the revised

1 statutes and codes of this state. Therefore, the following exceptions, exemptions, and 2 limitations are hereby continued in effect by incorporation into this Chapter by 3 citation: 4 (1) R.S. 3:556.10, 558.10, 559.9, 750, 1401, 1413, 1430.7, **1435,** 3204, 3221, 5 3370, 3421, 3524, 3706, 4021, 4110, 4162 6 7 Section 3. R.S. 3:1431(23) is hereby repealed in its entirety. 8 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 9 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 10 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 11 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 12 effective on the day following such approval.
