1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 2, change "eleven" to "nineteen"

20 (12) The executive director of the Louisiana Oil Marketers and Convenience
21 Store Association, or his designee.

22 (13) The executive director of the Beer Industry League of Louisiana Inc., or
23 his designee.

24 (14) The executive director of the Wine and Spirits Foundation of Louisiana,
25 or his designee.

26 (15) The executive director of the Louisiana Craft Brewers Guild, or his
27 designee.

28 (16) The president of the Louisiana Restaurant Association, or his designee.

29 (17) The president of the Louisiana Retailers Association, or his designee.

30 (18) A representative of a Louisiana registered third-party platform provider
31 who provides an e-commerce platform and operational resources for restaurants.

32 (19) A representative of a Louisiana registered third-party platform provider
33 who provides an e-commerce platform and operational resources for grocery stores.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that five members of the task force shall constitute
35 a quorum and the task force shall meet monthly at the state capitol starting July 1, 2018.

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the staff of the Senate Committee on Judiciary
37 B shall be the staff for the task force.

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall prepare and submit a final
39 report that contains a detailed statement of the findings and policy recommendations of the
40 task force to the governor, chairman of the House Judiciary Committee, and the chairman
41 of the Senate Committee on Judiciary B no later than March 8, 2019."
