EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

This measure is anticipated in increase self generated revenue for the Office of Public Health (OPH) by approximately \$75,000 in FY 19.

Present law provides that certain food service establishments shall hold a food safety certificate. Currently, OPH charges a fee of \$25 for a food safety certificate, which is valid for 5 years. Proposed law provides that retail food establishments that only sell prepackaged food items shall also hold a food safety certificate. There are approximately 3,000 retail food establishments that only sell prepackaged food items. Therefore, the total additional revenue generated by OPH as a result of this measure is anticipated to be approximately \$75,000 every 5 years (3,000 establishments x \$25 per certificate).
