COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS. Requests the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners and the Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology to work together in evaluating whether the practice of alternative hair design should be regulated by the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners.

2	To urge and request the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners and the Louisiana Board of
3	Cosmetology to work together in evaluating whether the practice of alternative hair
4	design should be regulated by the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners.
5	WHEREAS, alternative hair design, also known as hairbraiding, is regulated in
6	approximately twenty-six states and the regulatory schemes vary from state to state; and
7	WHEREAS, in Louisiana alternative hair design is presently regulated by the
8	Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology; and
9	WHEREAS, a study should be performed to determine whether alternative hair
10	design should be regulated by the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners; and
11	WHEREAS, both boards should work together in a study to determine the feasibility,
12	appropriateness, and potential advantages, if any, to regulation of alternative hair design by
13	the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners; and
14	WHEREAS, the boards should provide a report to the legislature not later than sixty
15	days before the start of the 2019 Regular Session of their study and conclusions.
16	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
17	does hereby urge and request the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners and the Louisiana
18	State Board of Cosmetology to work together in evaluating whether the practice of

alternative hair design should be regulated by the Louisiana Board of Barber Examiners, and report their findings to the legislature not later than sixty days before the start of the 2019 Regular Session.
