4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 2, after "To" insert "amend and reenact R.S. 47:481 and
5 R.S. 48:196(A)(introductory paragraph) and 197 and to"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 2, after "funds;" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 in its
8 entirety and insert the following:

9 "to provide relative to certain registration and license fees and taxes collected on
10 trucks and trailers; to provide for the collection, deposit, and appropriation of such
11 registration and license fees and taxes collected in certain parishes; to create the
12 Regional Maintenance and Improvement Fund; to provide for the deposit, use, and
13 investment of monies in the fund; to provide for the New Orleans Ferry Fund; to
14 repeal the termination date of the fund; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide
15 for related matters."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 1, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

18 "Section 1. R.S. 47:481 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 §481. Disposition of collections

20 Except as provided in R.S. 47:480, all fees and taxes provided for in this
21 Chapter, including the permit fees, shall be paid to the state treasurer on or before the
22 tenth day of each month following their collection and shall be credited to the
23 account of the Transportation Trust Fund, the State Highway Improvement Fund,
24 state highway fund No. 2, ~~and~~ the New Orleans Ferry Fund, **and the Regional**
25 **Maintenance and Improvement Fund**, as provided by law.

26 Section 2. R.S. 48:196(A)(introductory paragraph) and 197 are hereby amended and
27 reenacted to read as follows:

28 §196. State Highway Improvement Fund

29 A. There is hereby created, as a special fund in the state treasury, the State
30 Highway Improvement Fund, hereinafter referred to as the "fund." The source of
31 monies in this fund shall be registration and license fees and taxes collected by the
32 state pursuant to R.S. 47:462, and as provided in R.S. 47:481, in such amounts as
33 remain after payment of amounts due on bonds and related expenses as provided in

1 the documents pursuant to which the bonds were issued under the provisions of R.S.
 2 48:196.1. Beginning July 1, 2007, and each fiscal year thereafter, after satisfaction
 3 of the requirements of the provisions of R.S. 48:196.1 and compliance with the
 4 requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, and after
 5 making the allocation for state highway fund No. 2, ~~and the New Orleans Ferry~~
 6 ~~Fund, and the **Regional Maintenance and Improvement Fund**~~, the treasurer shall
 7 deposit into the fund the following amounts:

11 ~~**A.(1) Beginning From**~~ January 1, 2013, ~~and each fiscal year thereafter,~~
 12 **through June 30, 2018,** after compliance with the requirements of Article VII,
 13 Section 9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana, and after making the allocation for
 14 state highway fund No. 2, the treasurer shall deposit into the Transportation Trust
 15 Fund fifty percent of all funds derived from the collection of registration and license
 16 fees and taxes collected by the state pursuant to R.S. 47:462, and as provided in R.S.
 17 47:481, in the parishes of Orleans, Jefferson, St. John the Baptist, St. Charles,
 18 Tangipahoa, and St. Tammany.

19 **(2) Beginning July 1, 2018, and each fiscal year thereafter, after**
 20 **compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the**
 21 **Constitution of Louisiana, after making the allocation for state highway fund**
 22 **No. 2 for the Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission, and after making**
 23 **the allocation for the New Orleans Ferry Fund pursuant to R.S. 48:25.2, the**
 24 **treasurer shall deposit into the Transportation Trust Fund fifty percent of the**
 25 **remaining monies derived from the collection of registration and license fees**
 26 **and taxes collected by the state pursuant to R.S. 47:462, and as provided in R.S.**
 27 **47:481, in the parishes of Jefferson, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist,**
 28 **Tangipahoa, and St. Tammany.**

29 **B. There is hereby created, as a special fund in the state treasury, the**
 30 **Regional Maintenance and Improvement Fund, hereinafter referred to as the**
 31 **"fund". Beginning July 1, 2018, and each fiscal year thereafter, after**
 32 **compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the**
 33 **Constitution of Louisiana, after making the allocation for state highway fund**
 34 **No. 2 for the Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission, and after making**
 35 **the allocation for the New Orleans Ferry Fund pursuant to R.S. 48:25.2, the**
 36 **treasurer shall deposit into the fund fifty percent of the remaining monies**
 37 **derived from the collection of registration and license fees and taxes collected**
 38 **by the state pursuant to R.S. 47:462, and as provided in R.S. 47:481, in the**
 39 **parishes of Jefferson, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist, Tangipahoa, and St.**
 40 **Tammany.**

41 **C. The monies in the fund shall be subject to an annual appropriation**
 42 **by the legislature and shall be used only as provided in Subsection D of this**
 43 **Section. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the treasurer in the same**
 44 **manner as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest earned shall be**
 45 **deposited and credited to the fund. All unexpended or unencumbered monies**
 46 **remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain to the credit of**
 47 **the fund.**

48 **D. Monies appropriated from the fund shall be used exclusively for**
 49 **maintenance and improvements of state highways and non-federal aid routes**
 50 **in the respective parishes. Monies collected in the parishes of Jefferson,**
 51 **Tangipahoa, and St. Tammany shall be appropriated to the Regional Planning**
 52 **Commission. Monies collected in the parishes of St. Charles and St. John the**

1 **Baptist shall be appropriated to the South Central Planning and Development**
2 **Commission.**"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 5

4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 5, change "Section 1." to "Section 3."

5 AMENDMENT NO. 6

6 On page 2, delete lines 6 through 10 in their entirety and insert the following:

7 "Section 4. Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Act shall become effective upon signature of
8 this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for
9 bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section
10 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If this Act is vetoed by the governor and subsequently
11 approved by the legislature, Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Act shall become effective on the day
12 following such approval.

13 Section 5. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if
14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, Sections 1 and 2 of
15 this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018, or on the day following such approval by
16 the legislature, whichever is later."
