Provides relative to early release of offenders for "good time" and parole. (gov sig)

Proposed law provides for a report to the legislature relative to offenders released for "good time" as well a report to the legislature relative to offenders released on parole on or before August 1, 2018, and no later than August first of each year. Proposed law prohibits the release of any information relative to juvenile offenders pursuant to a public records request or otherwise deemed confidential by law and shall be redacted from the reports.
