Provides relative to the requirements for submission of DNA samples by peace officers

<u>Present law</u> requires any peace officer with a law enforcement agency hired after August 15, 2003, to submit a sample of DNA prior to starting employment duties and requires the hiring agency to submit the DNA to the appropriate criminal laboratory for testing.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement to submit the DNA sample to a laboratory for testing and instead requires the agency to collect and store all biological samples.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

<u>Present law</u> requires all law enforcement agencies to collect a DNA sample from each peace officer hired after August 15, 2003, and to submit the sample to a criminal laboratory for testing. In practice, law enforcement agencies are collecting these samples, but the samples are not being submitted for testing because there is no DNA sample available for comparison.

<u>Proposed law</u> eliminates the requirement to submit the collected DNA sample to a criminal laboratory for testing, and instead requires the law enforcement agency to store each collected sample. Law enforcement agencies would need to store each officer's sample in an individual secure envelop and retain them in a temperature controlled (room temperature) environment. Any cost associated with the storage of the collected DNA samples would be immaterial.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**
