Present law provides for the disclosure of vital records. Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law requires the state registrar to provide certain vital records to the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs upon written request for the purpose of determining veterans' benefits.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds that the state registrar of vital records may submit data related to deaths of veterans directly to the U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs in determining the eligibility of veterans benefits.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) indicates that any expenditure increase as a result of <u>proposed law</u> will be incremental in nature an can be absorbed utilizing existing budget authority. Currently, families are required to provide the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs with a copy of death records for the purpose of determining veterans' benefits. <u>Proposed law</u> will require LDH, upon written request, to submit a copy of a death record directly to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Furthermore, <u>proposed law</u> will allow LDH to transmit certain data to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs for the purpose of determining eligibility of veterans' benefits. LDH indicates that changes to the Louisiana Electronic Event Registration System (LEERS) are necessary to implement the data transmittal, but any additional costs would be covered under the current LEERS support and maintenance contract.
