## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law moves penalties related to fentanyl or its equivalents or carfentanil or a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of carfentanil or its analogues from Schedule I to Schedule II under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law. Fentanyl is currently a Schedule II substance. Proposed law makes technical adjustments to place corresponding penalties in the same section of law as its classification.
