## BY REPRESENTATIVES COUSSAN AND PIERRE

## AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 17:350.21, relative to funding of laboratory schools; to provide relative to inclusion of University of Louisiana at Lafayette as a public postsecondary education institution eligible to receive state funding for a laboratory school; to provide for the allocation of funds attributable to such inclusion; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 17:350.21 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§350.21. University laboratory schools operated by Louisiana State University and
Agricultural and Mechanical College and $\mathrm{by}_{2}$ Southern University and
Agricultural and Mechanical College, and University of Louisiana at
Lafayette; funding formula
A. Any elementary or secondary school operated by Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College or, by Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or University of Louisiana at Lafayette shall be considered a public elementary or secondary school and, as such, shall be annually appropriated funds as determined by applying the formula contained as specified in Subsection B of this Section.
B. Each student, as identified by the preceding year's October first membership, at the enrolled in a sehools school provided for in Subsection A of this Section shall be provided for and funded as provided for in Article VIII, Section 13 of the Constitution of Louisiana. The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education shall allocate annually from the minimum foundation program formula

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an amount per student in to each school equal to the amount allocated per student to the East Baton Rouge Parish Sehool Board school board in the parish where the school is located.
C. The funds appropriated for the schools provided for in this Section shall be allocated to the institution of fightrer postsecondary education operating strectrat the school. Eachsueh, and each institution of higher edueation shall expend such funds to operate stehsehools the school.
D. The funds provided pursuant to the provisions of this Section during any one fiscal year shall not supplant funding provided by a higher postsecondary education institution for the previous fiscal year to any elementary or secondary school operated by the institution.
E. Notwithstanding any provision of this Section to the contrary, the funding provided pursuant to the provisions of this Section shall not exceed the average per pupil funding provided by the minimum foundation program formula for other elementary or secondary schools operated by public postsecondary education institutions of higher edueation.
