ACT 529 (SB 293)

2018 Regular Session

Barrow

Prior law provided relative to board membership and the powers and duties of the State Licensing Board for Contractors (board).

New law increases the board membership as follows:

- (1) Members who have had the greater part of their experience as a licensed contractor in the fields of building or industrial construction, or both fields, from four to six.
- (2) Members from the public at large who do not earn their livelihood in a construction-related industry from two to three.
- (3) Adds a member from the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.

New law provides that beginning on July 1, 2018, and each quarter thereafter, the board shall submit to the presiding officer of each house of the legislature, by electronic or other means, a report that contains the following information for the previous quarter:

- (1) A list of licensees whose license has been suspended or revoked.
- (2) A list of any licensees whose license was reinstated.

New law increases the number of board members required for a quorum from eight to 10.

Effective August 1, 2018.
