11	E.(1) The owners of motor vehicles registered in other states or jurisdictions
12	that require liability security shall maintain the security and proof thereof as required
13	by their respective state or jurisdiction while the vehicle is operated in this state. $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$
14	personal injury protection card issued from an insurer in another state or
15	jurisdiction without a bodily injury endorsement shall not be sufficient proof
16	of liability security.

18	§872. Security and proof of financial responsibility required unless evidence of
19	insurance; when security determined; suspension; exception

21	D.(1) No such policy shall be effective under this Section unless issued by
22	an insurance company authorized to do business in the state of Louisiana, except that
23	if such the motor vehicle was not registered in this state or was a motor vehicle
24	which was registered elsewhere than in this state at the effective date of the policy,
25	or the most recent renewal thereof, such the policy shall not be effective under this
26	Section unless the insurance company issuing the policy, if not authorized to do

business in this state, shall execute executes a power of attorney authorizing the 2 commissioner to accept service on its behalf of notice of process in any action upon 3 such the policy arising out of such the accident. 4 (2) However, every such policy effective under this Section is subject, if the 5 accident has resulted in bodily injury or death, to a limit, exclusive of interest and costs, of not less than ten fifteen thousand dollars because of bodily injury to or 6 7 death of one person in any one accident and, subject to the limit for one person, to a limit of not less than twenty thirty thousand dollars because of bodily injury to or 8 9 death of two or more persons in any one accident and, if the accident has resulted in 10 injury to or destruction of property, to a limit of not less than ten twenty-five 11 thousand dollars because of injury to or destruction of property of others in any one 12 accident.
