1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:1665.2(B)(17) and (C)(4), relative to survivors of law enforcement officers  
3 killed while performing their duties; to provide for financial benefits for survivors  
4 of federal law enforcement agents killed in Louisiana; and to provide for related  
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "Deputy Marshal Josie Wells Act".

8 Section 2. R.S. 40:1665.2(B)(17) and (C)(4) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §1665.2. Financial security for surviving spouses and children of law enforcement
