<u>Prior law</u> allowed the commissioner, prior to Aug. 1, 2016, to waive all state application fees, or provide a credit for the fee, when a permit was not issued within three business days after receipt of a properly completed application for an alcohol beverage permit.

<u>New law</u> removes this provision which allowed the commissioner to waive the state application fee, or provide a credit for the fee, for permits when the permit was not issued within three business days after receipt of application.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that no parish or municipality shall require a permit or fee for an airline permitted as a "liquor retail distribution center".

<u>New law</u> amends the definition of a "liquor retail distribution center" to include only a commercial airline that stores alcoholic beverages in sealed containers of any size at any airport regularly served by the permittee.

Effective August 1, 2018.
