<u>Existing law</u> defines the practice of chiropractic. <u>Existing law</u> provides that the practice includes the use of mechanical devices.

<u>New law</u> specifies the use of mechanical traction and mechanical massage as mechanical devices.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that whenever a policy or contract provides for payment or reimbursement for any service, and the service is performed by a licensed chiropractor in this state, the chiropractor is entitled to payment or reimbursement. <u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and adds that this provision shall not affect any provision of the policy or contract regarding payment for services provided by a non-contracted provider.
