<u>Existing law</u> requires the identity of a health benefit plan insurer and sponsor to be displayed prominently on the face of the identification card or documentation.

<u>Prior law</u> required every identification card, membership card, insurance coverage card, or other documentation of coverage issued to any policyholder or health plan participant by a health insurer for a plan that is fully insured to include the phrase "Non-ERISA" prominently displayed on the face of the card or other documentation.

New law changes the required phrase to "Fully Insured".

Effective January 1, 2019.
