Existing law prohibits intentionally performing or attempting to perform an abortion of an unborn child of less than 20 weeks post-fertilization age without first providing the pregnant woman with an informational document including resources, programs, and services for pregnant women who have a diagnosis of fetal genetic abnormality and resources, programs, and services for infants and children born with disabilities.

New law retains existing law.

<u>New law</u> stipulates that no person shall be found in violation of <u>existing law</u>, and no penalty for a violation of <u>existing law</u> shall be assessed, in any instance in which the required informational document is not available for use.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 10, 2018).
