Existing law creates the Upper Audubon Security District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision to aid in crime prevention and reduction by providing additional security for district residents.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans to impose a parcel fee on behalf of the district, subject to voter approval. <u>Existing law</u> authorizes renewal of the fee, subject to voter approval. <u>Existing law</u> requires that the renewal election be held during a regularly scheduled election.

Sec. 2 of Act No. 372 of the 2017 RS (effective Jan. 1, 2019) requires the election be held only at the same time as the mayoral primary election. <u>New law</u> instead requires that the election be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled election.

Effective January 2, 2019.
