"Sixty" Rayburn Correctional Center in Angie, La., as the Deborah "Andi" Cook Memorial Education Building in honor of former education coordinator Deborah "Andi" Cook.

Proposed law is effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
