
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2019 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 503
by Representative Edmonds

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 6, delete "an exception" and insert in lieu thereof "exceptions; to provide an effective date;"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 2

2 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 19 in their entirety and insert the following:

3 "The legislature hereby finds all of the following:

4 (1) Studies have shown that an unemployed individual with a criminal record
5 is more likely to re-offend than an employed individual.

6 (2) A higher occupational level, such as being a part of a profession, is likely
7 to be related to a lower risk of recidivism.

8 (3) Removing any obstacles to employment after an individual has repaid his
9 debt to society is in the best interest of the state of Louisiana as a whole and for the
10 individual wishing to rejoin the workforce."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

12 On page 2, line 11, change "~~§54.~~" to "§54."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 4, line 12, after "§57." delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof
15 "Exceptions"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 4, line 13, change "for" to "to"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 4, line 14, after "to" delete the remainder of the line and line 15 in its entirety and
20 insert in lieu thereof: "all of the following:"

21 "(1) Any municipal, parish, state, or federal law enforcement agency.

22 (2) The Louisiana Real Estate Appraisers Board.

23 (3) The Louisiana Real Estate Commission.

24 (4) The Louisiana Supreme Court.

25 (5) The State Board of Certified Public Accountants of Louisiana."
