1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 11, delete lines 26 and 27 and insert

3 "(2) Meetings of the board shall be subject to the Open Meetings Law. The board
4 may hold regular or special meetings outside of Baton Rouge at a location within the
5 state after proper notice has been provided to the public. Meetings outside of Baton
6 Rouge shall be held at a meeting space located in a public building and open to the
7 public for the purposes of the meeting. At least a majority of the regular monthly
8 meetings of the board each year shall be held in Baton Rouge."
