Amendments proposed by Senator Walsworth to Engrossed House Bill No. 168 by Representative Hodges

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendment No. 3 (designated as SCAHB168 CLEMENTA
3 2628), proposed by the Senate Committee on Judiciary C and adopted by the Senate on May
4 29, 2019.

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, after line 15, insert the following:

7 "C.(1) ~~Whoever~~ Except as provided in Paragraph (3) of this Subsection,
8 whoever commits the crime of filing false public records shall be imprisoned for not
9 more than five years with or without hard labor or shall be fined not more than five
10 thousand dollars, or both.

11 (2) In addition to the penalty provided for in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection,
12 a person convicted of the provisions of this Section may be ordered to pay restitution
13 to the state if the state suffered a loss as a result of the offense. Restitution shall
14 include, but not be limited to, the payment of legal interest at the rate provided in
15 R.S. 13:4202.

16 (3) Whoever violates the provisions of Paragraph (A)(4) of this Section shall
17 be fined not more than two thousand dollars or be imprisoned, with or without hard
18 labor, for not more than two years, or both, for the first offense. On a second offense,
19 or any subsequent offense, the penalty shall be a fine of not more than five thousand
20 dollars or imprisonment at hard labor for not more than five years, or both."
