PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS: Authorizes certain parishes to name certain facilities in honor of living persons

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Authorizes the governing authority of a parish with a population of not less than 340,000 persons and not more than 420,000 persons to name certain buildings, parks, and civic complexes in honor of a living person.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that, except as otherwise provided by law, no public building owned by the state or by any political subdivision of the state or by any institution receiving its support in whole or in part from the state shall be named in honor of any living person.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the governing authority of a parish with a population of not less than 340,000 persons and not more than 435,000 persons to name certain buildings, parks, and civic complexes in honor of a living person.
