ACT 127 (SB 174)

Prior law provided for an annual appropriation for the councils on aging. Present law provides for an allocation of \$2.50 per person age 60 or older in the parish based on the latest official census estimate. New law retains prior law.

Prior law provided for a minimum allocation per parish in the amount of \$37,500. New law increases the per parish minimum from \$37,500 to \$100,000.

Prior law provided for a total minimum annual appropriation for the councils on aging in the amount of \$2,776,800. New law increases the total minimum annual appropriation from \$2,776,800 to \$6,900,000.

New law removes provision providing a maximum allocation for any one parish council on aging of \$100,000 unless additional funds are appropriated.

Effective August 1, 2019.
