Present law defines "child day care center" as any place or facility operated by any institution, political subdivision, society, agency, corporation, person or persons, or any other group for the purpose of providing care, supervision, and guidance of seven or more children, not including those related to the caregiver, unaccompanied by parent or legal custodian, on a regular basis for at least twelve and one-half hours in a continuous seven-day week. Present law also defines "related" or "relative" to mean a natural or adopted child or grandchild of the caregiver or a child in the legal custody of the caregiver.

Proposed law removes the exception for children related to the caregiver and deletes the definition of "related" or "relative".

Effective August 1, 2020.
