<u>Present law</u> provides for the return of certain charter schools from the Recovery School District (RSD) to the transferring local school system.

<u>Present law</u> allows a lottery preference for enrollment at elementary and middle schools for students residing within defined geographic zones as a factor to determine student assignment, according to policies adopted by the board.

<u>Present law</u> further provides such preference shall be applied to not more than one-half of the seats available in each grade level and that a charter school authorized on or prior to July 1, 2016, may maintain any existing geographic preferences.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the lottery preference for students residing within the defined geographic zones to not more than seventy-five percent of the seats available in each grade level.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
