AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 23:921(M), relative to employment contracts; to prohibit certain contracts
3	restricting a physician from the practice of medicine outside of the parish in which
4	the physician is employed; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 23:921(M) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§921. Restraint of business prohibited; restraint on forum prohibited; competing
8	business; contracts against engaging in; provisions for
9	* * *
10	M. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no contract,
11	agreement, or provision in a contract or agreement which restricts a physician
12	from the practice of medicine outside the parish in which the physician is
13	employed and two additional contiguous parishes for a period exceeding two
14	years from the date the physician ceases employment shall be enforceable.
