HOUSE BILL NO. 667

BY REPRESENTATIVE AMEDEE

INSURANCE/HEALTH: Prohibits financial incentives or penalties to encourage healthcare providers to administer vaccinations

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 22:1008.1, relative to prohibited health insurance incentives; to prohibit the  
3 payment of a financial reward to a healthcare provider to encourage vaccination; to  
4 prohibit the denial of a claim or other penalties to encourage vaccination; to define  
5 key terms; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 22:1008.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1008.1. Health coverage plans; prohibited provider incentives

9 A. No health coverage plan shall pay or offer to pay to any healthcare  
10 provider an incentive, bonus, or other amount beyond the contracted reimbursement  
11 rate for a covered healthcare service with the intent to, directly or indirectly,  
12 influence, persuade, or encourage the healthcare provider to administer any  
13 vaccination.

14 B. No health coverage plan shall deny or otherwise refuse to reimburse any  
15 claim for a covered healthcare service submitted by a healthcare provider or impose  
16 any other penalty on a healthcare provider with the intent to, directly or indirectly,  
17 influence, persuade, or encourage the healthcare provider to administer any  
18 vaccination.

19 C. For purposes of this Section, "health coverage plan" means any hospital,  
20 health, or medical expense insurance policy, hospital or medical service contract,

1 employee welfare benefit plan, contract, or other agreement with a health  
2 maintenance organization or a preferred provider organization, health and accident  
3 insurance policy, or any other insurance contract of this type in this state, including  
4 a group insurance plan, a self-insurance plan, and the Office of Group Benefits  
5 programs. "Health coverage plan" shall not include a plan providing coverage for  
6 excepted benefits as defined in R.S. 22:1061, limited benefit health insurance plans,  
7 and short-term policies that have a term of less than twelve months.

**Abstract:** Prohibits health insurers from offering financial incentives or imposing penalties to encourage healthcare providers to administer vaccinations.

Proposed law prohibits a health coverage plan from paying or offering to pay to any healthcare provider an incentive, bonus, or other amount beyond the contracted reimbursement rate for a covered healthcare service with the intent to, directly or indirectly, influence, persuade, or encourage the healthcare provider to administer any vaccination.

Proposed law prohibits a health coverage plan from denying or otherwise refusing to reimburse any claim for a covered healthcare service submitted by a healthcare provider or imposing any other penalty on a healthcare provider with the intent to, directly or indirectly, influence, persuade, or encourage the healthcare provider to administer any vaccination.
