MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides relative to amber warning lamps; vehicles hauling forest products. (8/1/20)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 32:308(G), relative to motor vehicle equipment; to provide relative to amber warning lamps; to provide relative to vehicles hauling forest products; to provide for requirements; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:308(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§308. Additional equipment required on buses, trucks, truck tractors, trailers, semi-trailers ~~and pole trailers~~, **pole trailers, and any commercial motor vehicle or trailer designed to transport a load of unprocessed logs or pulpwood**

\* \* \*

**G. Any commercial motor vehicle or trailer designed to transport a load of unprocessed logs or pulpwood may show or display a flashing amber light when in operation or a hazard exists.**

Present law provides for equipment requirements for buses, trucks, truck tractors, trailers, semi-trailers, and pole trailers.

Proposed law retains present law and further provides that any commercial motor vehicle or trailer designed to transport a load of unprocessed logs or pulpwood, may show or display a flashing amber light.
