(a) Availability of the collaborating physician who shall be licensed to practice and be domiciled in Louisiana, or dentist for consultation or referral, or both.

<u>Present law</u> defines "collaborative practice agreement" as a formal written statement addressing the parameters of the collaborative practice which are mutually agreed upon by the advanced practice registered nurse and one or more licensed physicians or dentists. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a requirement that the agreement is subject to joint approval by the LSBN and the LSBME or LSBD.

<u>Present law</u> requires a collaborating physician to be available for consultation or referral, or both. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a requirement that the collaborating physician must be licensed to practice and be domiciled in Louisiana.

Effective August 1, 2020.
