HEALTH SERVICES

OR NO IMPACT See Note

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Requires the provision of certain information to patients or parents of patients prior to administration of an immunization or a vaccine

Proposed law requires that prior to administering an immunization or a vaccine to a patient, the provider administering the immunization or vaccine shall provide to the patient thorough information in writing, verbally, or electronically that addresses, at minimum, all of the following:

- (1) The diseases or conditions that the immunization or vaccine is intended to prevent or treat.
- (2) The effectiveness of the immunization or vaccine.
- (3) Any contraindications associated with the immunization or vaccine.
- (4) The possible side effects of the immunization or vaccine.
- (5) The ingredients of the immunization or vaccine.
- (6) Instructions for submitting a report to the federally managed Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System.
