SENATE BILL NO. 497

BY SENATOR BARROW

VOTERS/VOTING. Allows a voter to request his absentee by mail ballot be rescinded in the event an election is delayed as a result of a declared state of emergency. (8/1/20)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 18:1308(D), relative to absentee by mail voting; to provide for the ability to

3 rescind an absentee by mail ballot in the event of a declared emergency; to provide

4 for appropriate rules and materials; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 18:1308(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §1308. Absentee voting by mail

8 * * *

9 **D.(1) Notwithstanding any applicable provision of this Chapter, in the**

10 **event an election is delayed as a result of a state of emergency declared pursuant**

11 **to R.S. 24:742(B)(1), a voter may request to rescind his absentee by mail ballot**

12 **if the ballot was submitted prior to the declared state of emergency.**

13 **(2) Rules and instructions for the protocol established in Paragraph (1)**

14 **of this Subsection shall be promulgated and prepared by the secretary of state**

15 **in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act and included in the**

16 **materials provided for in R.S. 18:1306(B)(1).**
