Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 351 by Senator Cathey

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "443.1(B)," delete "and"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 3, after "(7)" insert ", and 444(B)(1) and to enact R.S. 18:443(G),"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 6, after "443.1(B)," delete "and"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 1, line 7, after "(7)" delete the remainder of the line and insert ", and 444(B)(1) are
9 hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 18:443(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, between lines 15 and 16 insert:

12 **"G.(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 18:443(B)(1), in the event an**
13 **election for members of any such state central committee does not occur at the same**
14 **time as the presidential preference primary in 2020, the members of the state central**
15 **committee shall be elected at the runoff of the next regularly scheduled election**
16 **presently scheduled for December 5, 2020. The secretary of state shall select the dates**
17 **for qualification of candidates, conforming as closely as practicable with the timelines**
18 **established in R.S. 18:467.**

19 **(2) The provisions of this Subsection shall be effective only until June 1, 2021."**

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 3, between lines 28 and 29 insert the following:

22 "§444. Parish executive committees

23 * * *

24 B. Election and term. (1) Members of a parish executive committee of a recognized
25 political party shall be elected every four years at the same time as the presidential
26 preference primary election. ~~The term of office shall not extend beyond the time for which~~
27 ~~the member was elected. Notwithstanding this provision, members elected in 1991 shall~~
28 ~~serve until their successors are chosen.~~ **The term of office of the members shall be until**
29 **their successors are qualified and elected.**
