Abstract: Amends certain expungement forms.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the expungement of criminal records and provides for the forms which shall be used to seek an expungement.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> forms for a motion for expungement, order of expungement, and supplemental forms to include options for which a person received a first offender pardon for an eligible offense pursuant to <u>present law</u>.

(Amends C.Cr.P. Arts. 989, 992, and 993)
