16	endorsements, amendments, or riders \$25.00

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2020.

Present law requires the commissioner of insurance to collect in advance the following fees:

- (1) For each company filing of property and casualty insurance policy forms, per product \$100.00
- (2) For each company filing to adopt a reference or item filing of advisory organization's form reference filing (not applicable to service purchasers, who must file the actual forms as shown above) \$20.00
- (3) For each company filing of property and casualty insurance policy endorsements, amendments, or riders \$25.00

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the \$100 fee for each property and casualty insurance policy and instead requires collection of \$50 for each form filing of property and casualty insurance policy.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the \$20 fee collected for each company filing to adopt a reference or item filing of advisory organization's form reference filing, but which is not applicable to service purchasers, who must file the actual forms required by law.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the \$25 fee for each company filing of property and casualty insurance policy endorsements, amendments, or riders.

Effective July 1, 2020.
