A RESOLUTION

To commend Joseph Michael Srofe Jr. of the Boy Scouts of America Troop 562 on achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend and celebrate the accomplishments of Joseph Michael Srofe Jr. of Boy Scouts of America Troop 562 on the memorable and historic occasion of his attainment of the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America was organized in 1910 to provide boys an educational program to build character, to train in the responsibilities of citizenship, and to develop personal fitness; and
