Hensgens

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a taxpayer to donate any portion of his state income tax refund to a donee listed on the tax return form as a checkoff.

<u>Present law</u> requires that a checkoff donation be removed from the tax return form if donations to a particular donee do not equal \$10,000 or more for two consecutive years.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains these provisions but exempts Dreams Come True, Inc. from the \$10,000 requirement. Further provides that this exemption will expire on January 1, 2024.

Proposed law applies to taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2020.

Effective August 1, 2020.
