Proposed legislation expands the use of sick leave policies for unclassfied, nonteaching, academic personnel employed by the management boards of higher education. Expands the use of sick leave to include care for an immediate family member who is ill or injured; accompanying an immediate family member to a medical, dental, or optical consultation or treatment. Defines immediate family member as a spouse, parent, or child of an employee.
