PUBLIC CONTRACTS: Provides relative to payments under public contract

2	To enact R.S. 38:2211(A)(14) and 2248(C), relative to payment of obligations arising under
3	public contracts; to allow public entities to withhold liquidated damages for public
4	works contracts under certain circumstances; to provide for definitions; and to
5	provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 38:2211(A)(14) and 2248(C) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§2211. Definitions
9	A. As used in this Chapter unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
10	following terms shall mean:

12	(14) "Liquidated Damages" means a fixed sum of damages stipulated in a
13	public works construction contract that are intended to compensate a public entity
14	as a result of a delay in performance by the contractor and may be assessed for a
15	project not being substantially complete within the time provided for by the public
16	works contract.

1	C. A public entity letting a public works construction contract, as per the
2	terms of the contract, may withhold liquidated damages from any payments or
3	monies otherwise due to the contractor, taking into consideration all granted time
4	extensions.

Abstract: Allows public entities to withhold liquidated damages for public works contracts.

<u>Present law</u> provides for definitions relative to public contracts.

Proposed law adds a definition for "liquidated damages".

Present law provides provisions for withholding payments for public works contracts.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a provision allowing a public entity letting a public works construction contract to withhold liquidated damages from monies due to the contractor.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:
- 1. Grant limited authority to waive prompt payment obligations by contract for liquidated or delay damages.

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

- 1. Remove authority to waive prompt payment obligations by contract for liquidated or delay damages.
- 2. Define "liquidated damages".
- 3. Add a provision allowing a public entity letting a public works construction contract to withhold liquidated damages from monies due to the contractor.
