| 6 | Louisiana, where she worked for more than twenty years to revitalize and bring greater |
| 7 | awareness of the language, history, and culture of the Louisiana Creole people; and |
| 8 | WHEREAS, Janet Ravare-Colson organized hundreds of workshops, seminars, and |
| 9 | conferences that brought local, state, national, and international scholars and community |
| 10 | leaders from various communities together to highlight the contemporary experiences of |
| 11 | Louisiana Creoles and other Creole communities around the world during a period when |
| 12 | these communities suffered from neglect and misrepresentation; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, Ms. Ravare-Colson expanded the body of literature, genealogical |
| 14 | research, and public visibility of one of the nation's oldest and least documented ethnic |
| 15 | groups, thereby contributing to the advancement and educational development of future |
| 16 | generations of Creoles; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, she also mentored and educated dozens of Louisiana Creole scholars, |
| 18 | musicians, genealogists, and cultural preservationists throughout her career; Janet Ravare- |
| 19 | Colson, daughter of Louisiana Creole heritage, was tirelessly committed to the preservation |
| 20 | of the Creole community, and for this, she is certainly worthy of recognition; and |

1 WHEREAS, in honor of Janet Ravare-Colson's work to preserve Creole heritage,

- 2 March twenty-first, her birthday, will be recognized as a day to celebrate her contributions
- 3 to preserving Creole culture throughout the state of Louisiana.
