

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
2 request that the United States Congress take action to appropriate the necessary funds for the
3 U.S. Department of Agriculture and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration to take
4 immediate measures to significantly increase the level of seafood inspection at the sites
5 where it is harvested and at our borders.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby requests that
7 the United States require every lot of imported seafood to enter our border with a full lab
8 certificate ensuring compliance with our food and drug laws.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
10 presiding officers of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Congress of the
11 United States of America and to each member of the Louisiana congressional delegation.
