1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 3, after "emergency;" and before "and" insert "to provide relative to claims
- 3 pursuant to the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:

6	B. An employee whose contraction of COVID-19 is determined to be
7	compensable under the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law shall have no
8	remedy based in tort for such exposure against his employer, joint employer,
9	borrowed employer, statutory employer, any other person or entity listed in
10	R.S. 23:1032(A)(1)(b), and any other person or entity potentially liable pursuant
11	to the Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law unless the exposure was
12	intentional as provided by R.S. 23:1032(B).

C. Notwithstanding the rights of employees as provided by R.S.
23:1032(B), employees who contract COVID-19 and are not covered by the
Louisiana Workers' Compensation Law shall have no remedy in tort for such
exposure against their employer, joint employer, borrowed employer, statutory
employer, any other person or entity listed in R.S. 23:1032(A)(1)(b), and any
other person or entity potentially liable pursuant to the Louisiana Workers'
Compensation Law unless the exposure was caused by intentional act."
