1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Amendment Set 2135 proposed by the Senate Committee on Education and adopted
3 by the Senate on May 28, 2020

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 2, after "debt;" delete the remainder of the line, and on line 3, delete
6 "institutions" and insert "to allow public postsecondary education management boards to
7 adopt policies to prohibit the institutions under their supervision and management"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 15

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, at the beginning of line 16, change "(2)" to "(1)"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 2, at the beginning of line 1, change "(3)" to "(2)"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 2, line 3, after "law," delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:

16 "each public postsecondary education management board may adopt a policy to
17 prohibit the institutions under its supervision and management from doing any of the"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 2, line 7, change "(2)" to "(2)(a)"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 2, at the end of line 8, before the period "." insert "or enrollment in a repayment
22 plan"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 9

24 On page 2, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

25 "(b) Any repayment plan established as a precondition of providing a transcript shall
26 include a monthly payment amount. The monthly payment amount shall be
27 established with consideration of the current or former student's ability to pay and
28 shall not exceed fifteen percent of the student's monthly income."
